

Minnewaska State Park Preserve **Rules and Regulations**

Patrons are responsible to understand and obey these regulations. Violations may result in revocation of park privileges and/or legal prosecution.



This park is limited to day use only. Overnight camping and camp fires are not permitted.



All plants and animals are protected. Please do not harass the wildlife.



This is a carry-in/carry-out New York State Park. Trash receptacles are not provided; you must take your trash out with you. Help keep our state parks clean.



Pets are permitted on a six-foot leash only.



Alcoholic beverages are not permitted.



For your own safety, remain on designated carriageways and footpaths.



Bicyclists Must: Wear helmets, only ride on established carriageways, yield and give warning to pedestrians and horses, ride in a safe manner, and obey all park rules and regulations.



Swimmers Must: Swim only at designated areas in Lake Minnewaska and Lake Awosting when life guards are on duty.

Hours and Fees

The Park Preserve opens daily at 9:00 a.m. year-round. User fees and closing hours are posted at the Park Preserve entrances and are adjusted seasonally. Information is available at the gatehouses and Park Preserve office regarding Empire Passports for frequent park users, senior citizens' discount, and Access Passes. Empire Passports are not valid when the Park Preserve is charging a per head trail fee.

Recreational Activities

Hiking, biking, horseback riding, scuba diving, swimming, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, picnicking, non-motorized boating, bouldering and rock climbing.


Public Programs
